This is a generic instruction sheet created by the credit union as a convenience to our members. Please note that you may be required to complete a separate form for the sending financial.

**Instructions:**

1. Contact the sending financial and give them the following information to send your wire transfer.

**Note: For incoming foreign wires transfers, Summit does not have a Swift Code, IBAN or other international routing code, nor do we have a correspondent bank. You are able to wire funds directly to your Summit Credit Union account using our ABA routing number: 275979034. International financial institutions will have a US corresponding bank that will transfer the funds to Summit.**
